Biography: Boldyrev Nikolay Nikolayevich is a distinguished Russian scholar, professor, and academic leader specializing in cognitive linguistics, figurative language studies, and lexicology. He is the author of more than 410 scientific publications, monographs, textbooks, and research articles published in local and international academic journals.

From August 1977 until now has been affiliated with this institute (which in 1994 was reorganized into Tambov state university named after G.R. Derzhavin) first as tutor, then: senior lecturer, assistant professor, associate professor, professor, head of the department (13 years), dean of the faculty (5 years), vice-rector for science and research (18 years), director of the Cognitive research center (at present time).
