Biography: Dr. Solijon Uchmas ogli Azizov is one of the promising young scholars of Uzbekistan and holds a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree in Pedagogical Sciences (2025). He is currently pursuing the Doctor of Science (DSc) degree in Comparative and Contrastive Linguistics at Uzbekistan State World Languages University. His research interests encompass foreign language education, comparative linguistics, cognitive linguistics, literary discourse analysis, and the application of blended learning technologies in higher education.

Dr. Azizov has published nearly 70 scientific articles and conference papers in the fields of pedagogy, philology, and linguistics. His scholarly work focuses on foreign language teaching methodology, English writing competence, comparative and cognitive linguistics, as well as the conceptual analysis of the phenomena of crime and justice in English and Uzbek literary discourse. Approximately 30 of his articles have been published in academic journals recommended by the Supreme Attestation Commission under the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, while around 10 papers have appeared in international peer-reviewed journals. His current H-index is 3.

He is the author of the monograph *Blended Learning Technologies in Enhancing Writing Competence* and has actively participated in more than 30 national and international scientific conferences, including numerous presentations as a keynote speaker. Dr. Azizov was awarded the Presidential State Scholarship of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of Foreign Languages (Master's level, 2019) and has received several first- and second-place diplomas in the categories of "Best Speaker", "Best Paper", and "Best Presentation".

In addition to his research activities, Dr. Azizov serves as the Editor of the electronic scientific and methodological journal *Philology Matters*, contributing to the improvement of its academic quality and international visibility. Through his research, publications, editorial work, and academic leadership, he continues to make a valuable contribution to the advancement of linguistics, philology, and foreign language education in Uzbekistan.

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
