

**Full name:** Professor Dr. Ilyos Ismoilov

**Specialization:** History of Uzbek Literature and Comparative Literary Studies

**Biography:** Professor Dr. Ilyos Ismoilov is a scholar with a growing H-index (h=2), holding a PhD in Comparative Literature and Translation Studies (2019) and a DSc in the History of Uzbek Literature (2023).

His multidisciplinary research expertise encompasses Eastern classical literature, particularly the history of Uzbek literature, the works of Alisher Navoi, the tradition of Khamsa writing (comparative analysis of the Xamsas of Nizami Ganjavi, Khusrav Dehlavi, and Abdurahman Jami), Sufi literature, and issues in comparative literary studies.

Professor Ilyos Ismoilov has authored nearly 100 academic publications, including 10 books and 80 articles published in prestigious international and national journals. He is currently supervising 7 PhD and postdoctoral researchers and has previously supervised more than 10 M.Phil./M.Sc./BS research students.

### **Scientific projects and initiatives:**

Professor Ilyos Ismoilov has implemented scientific projects funded by the Agency for Innovative Development of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Center for Islamic Civilization in Uzbekistan (CICU).

His most significant projects include the following:

- Participant in the fundamental project “Publication of the multi-volume monograph “History of Uzbek Literature” (7 volumes)”, No. OT-FI-030, conducted at the Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature from 2017 to 2020.

- Contributor to the applied project “Creation of scientific commentaries and interpretations of the ghazals in Alisher Navoi’s divan “Gharaib al-Sighar” (Wonders of Childhood) in Uzbek and English”, No. PZ-20170930393, conducted at the Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies from 2018 to 2020.

- Participant in the scientific-practical project “History of Navoi Studies (20th-21st centuries)”, No. PZ-20170926459, conducted at the Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature from 2018 to 2020.

- Contributor to the educational project developing scripts for the “Javohir” (Gems) television series, broadcast on the “History of Uzbekistan” channel of the National Television and Radio Company of Uzbekistan from 2019 to 2022.
