Doctor of Philological Sciences, Professor, Dilbar Rakhimovna Dzhumanova is a distinguished scholar with a H index of 4. She holds a PhD degree in Speciality Code 13.00.02 – Methodology of Teaching the Russian Language (1992) and a Doctor of Sciences (DSc) degree in Speciality Code 10.00.06 – Comparative Literature, Contrastive Linguistics and Translation Studies (2016).

Her interdisciplinary research experience encompasses comparative linguistics and translation studies, intercultural communication, linguistic cognition, and linguoculturology. She is the author of two monographs and textbooks on Russian phonetics, lexicology, and lexicography. In addition, she is engaged in translation from Uzbek into Russian and in editing Russian-language texts.

Professor Dilbar Rakhimovna Dzhumanova has authored more than 190 scientific publications in international and national journals and conference proceedings.

Her scholarly works have received more than 20 citations, and her H index is 4.

She has supervised more than 144 Master's degree students (including students from China and India) who have completed their studies. She has successfully supervised 9 PhD in Philological Sciences and 3 in Pedagogical Sciences. Currently, she supervises 7 doctoral candidates who are at the final stage of their research, including 3 candidates pursuing the Doctor of Sciences (DSc) degree.

As part of her project activities, she has collaborated with Syktyvkar University (2021–2025). She also participated in the joint international project No. EAPI2020-027, *“Preservation of National (State) Languages in the Multilingual Space of Digital and Smart Societies,”* implemented in cooperation with Russia and Belarus (2020–2021).

She maintains active international scientific cooperation with universities in Russia and Kazakhstan.

Professor D.R. Dzhumanova has organized and conducted 11 international scientific conferences: “Slavic and Turkic Languages in World Culture” (6 conferences) and “Methodology and Methods of Research in the Humanities” (5 conferences).

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
